In conjunction with CMI and Church of All Nations, the C.A.L.E.B. Centers (Caribbean, African, Latin America Education Benevolence) in South America are moving forward and operating under the guidelines set forth by CMI. All resources received go directly to the children. These facilities have feeding programs, they provide clothes, parenting skills, counseling, tutoring for school, medical clinics, physical and oral hygiene, arts and crafts, story time as well as sports and social activities. Regular reports are received, detailing each center's progress and needs.

Our current South American centers include the following:

URUGUAY: Club de la Aventura, Montevideo - 80 children are ministered to under the leadership of Pr. Javier and Viviana de Paula.

Gane Punta De Rieles, Montevideo - 70 children are ministered to under the leadership of Pr. Dario and Adriana Pereira.

BOLIVIA: Church of All Nations, Santa Cruz - 120 children are ministered to under the leadership of Pr. Eduardo and Vilanir Delgado.

La Costanera, Santa Cruz - 80 children are ministered to under the leadership of Pr. Dario Cartegena.

Plan 3000, Santa Cruz - 100 at-risk children are ministered to under the leadership of Pr. Hugo Peralta.

PERU: Grandmales, Lima - 50 children are under the direction of Pr. German Orillo.

Center, Pisco - 58 children are under the direction of Pr. Julio and Sandra Gutierrez.

Chorillos, Lima - 60 children are under the direction of Pr. Milagros.

ARGENTINA: CALEB Center, Buenos Aires - 45 children are under the direction of Pr. Juan and Sandra Pacheco.

In Ghana, Pr. Paul Doe and in India, Pr. Frank Godberg John are responsible for over a total of 2200 children.





INDIA MEDICAL CAMP

Frank Godberg John and the church in Kolar Gold Field, South India, held a free medical camp exclusively for cardiology.

300 patients were seen and treated, with free medication distributed. Services that were provided included EKG, ECHO, blood sugar and blood pressure checks.

This special event was coordinated with the famous Narayana Hrudhalya Cardiology Research Centre in Bangalore. They appreciated the cooperation to help the poor and needy.
