They visit primarily beaches, but will go where the Lord directs them. They meet for prayer, worship and instruction, and then go out 2-by-2, handing out tracts, talking with people, offering to pray with them, and ultimately share the Gospel and lead individuals in the sinner’s prayer.

Evangelina states, “Evangelism is a very important part of church life and should be done by everyone.” Participants are encouraged to have their own solid prayer life and to follow the example as spelled out in the Book of Acts.
